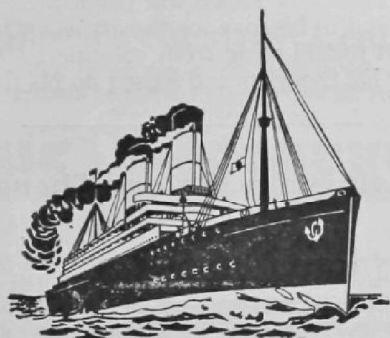


Where the Crescendo Goes

Jos. Wright of Christchurch, New Zealand

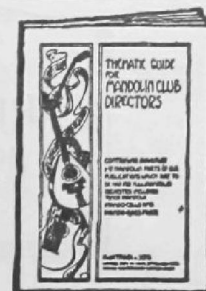
Jos. Wright began the study of music at the age of 15, playing cornet in several bands. On account of ill health, he was compelled to abandon wind instruments for string. He now teaches mandolin, guitar and banjo. His pupils number into the hundreds. Mr. Wright was the first teacher to give concerts of the stringed instruments in Christchurch and has continued these every season. He is the director of the Christchurch Mandolin Orchestra of 30 members. His concerts given yearly have been largely attended and the work of the orchestra has received much praise from the local press.

There is considerable interest in all the instruments in New Zealand and Mr. Wright must be credited with having furthered their interest to a considerable extent.



Christchurch is a town of New Zealand on So. Island which is the capital of the Province of Canterbury. It is on the Avon River, 7 miles from the sea.
